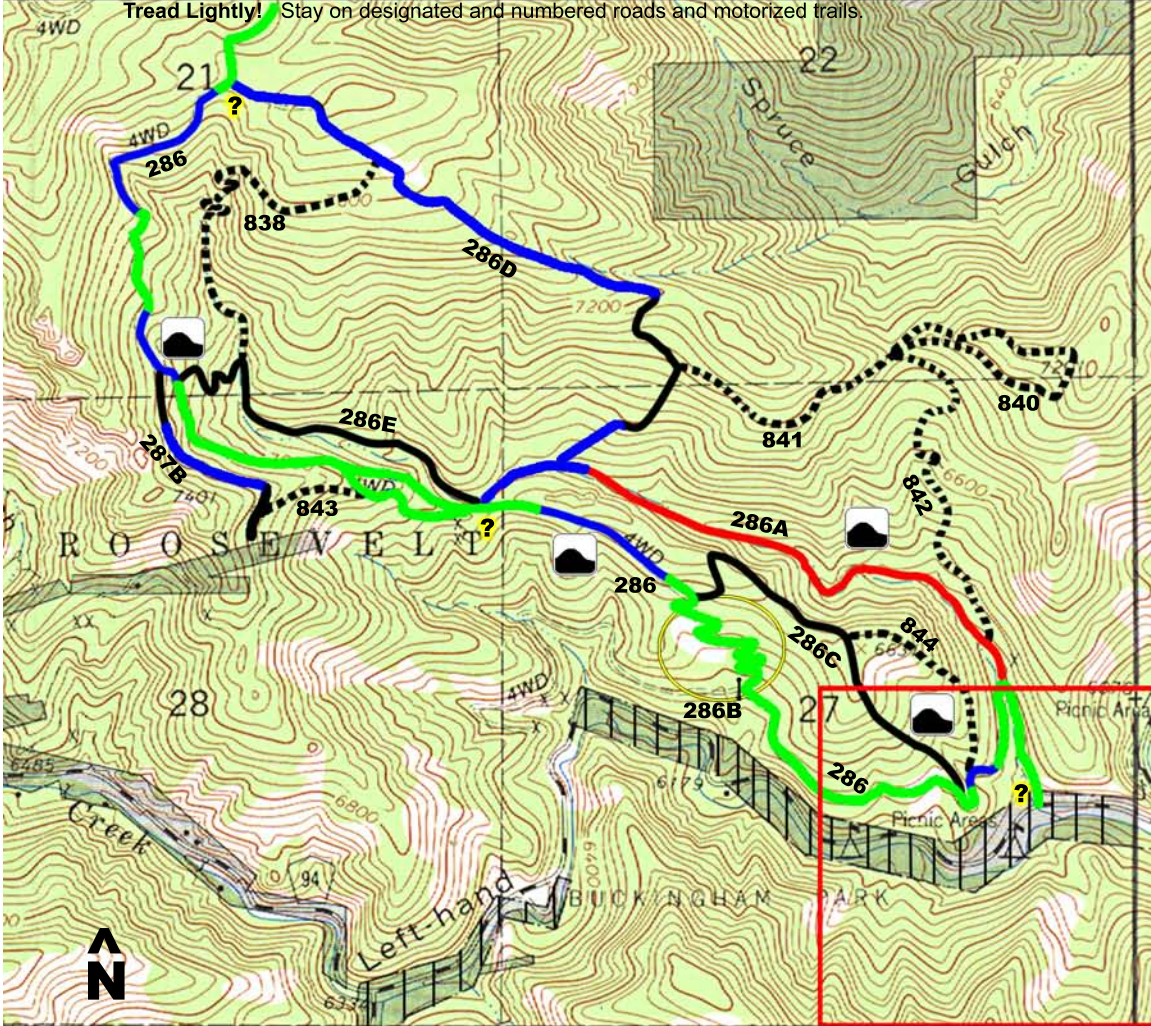

F.S. #	Common Name	Description
286	Lefthand Main	More Difficult (Moderate). Obstacles include the Gulch, Tipping Rock and Squeeze.
286A	Carnage Canyon	Extreme. Obstacles include the Gauntlet, Slab and Waterfall.
286B		Closed due to safety issues.
286C	Mother Hill	Most Difficult. Mother Hill is a side route off of Lefthand Main. It is a long hill climb.
286D	Fireman Hill	Extreme. Fireman Hill contains one obstacle, the Chute.
286E	Upper Carnage	Most Difficult. Follows the gulch bottom with a steep climb to Lefthand Main.
287B	Castle Gulch Ridge	Most Difficult. Obstacle is at the merge with Lefthand Main.
Motorized Trails		
F.S. #	Common Name	Description
838	Cavanaugh's Trail	Most Difficult from north to south, Extreme from south to north. Roller rocks with steep sidehills.
840	Saddle Trail Loop	Most Difficult. Recommended direction is counter clockwise.
841	Saddle Trail West	Most Difficult. Narrow ledge trail with several rock jumps on side hills.
842	Saddle Trail East	Most Difficult north to south, Extreme going south to north. Trail has roller rocks with several deep ruts.
843	Wiltz's Trail	Most Difficult from west to east, Extreme from east to west. Several ledges to climb over.
844	Bauman's Ridge Trail	Most Difficult. Very steep with roller rocks. Preferred direction is north to south.
